

⇒ Example Guben

- Citizen survey (2004)
 - Joint project
 - Objective target: finding out the perception of the urban renewal process and its results among the town populace
 - categories: satisfaction with appartment, living environment ...











- e.g. Guben (ongoing)
 - Creation of a municipal integrated energy concept on the basis of the integrated urban development concept (INSEK)
 - Focal point of participation to date → energy suppliers and real estate companies / housing cooperatives
- e.g. Spreewalddreieck (ongoing)
 - Development of a regional communication platform
 - Creation of a regional energy concept
- e.g. energy region GOMS (CH) (ongoing)





- **⇒** Example Guben
- An integrated energy concept is the basis of decisionmaking for a cost-efficient and sustainable energy supply
- Local town and settlement structures taken into account in concept preparation









- **⇒** Example Guben
- Creation of advisory groups
- Workshop with all town stake holders (including utility companies, industry, politics, experts, populace)
- Awareness building and acceptance











⇒ Example Spreewalddreieck

- Pilot project of the national urban development policy
- Objective: setting up a communication platform for all relevant stake holders, creation of a regional energy concept and preparation of individual concrete energy-saving measures
- Local authorities as initiators and moderators of the process

- Informational events for citizens, stake holders
 / (potential) partners
- Homepage with newsletter subscription
- Energy project weeks in school classes













3. In a nutshell ...

- Active and continuous citizen participation in terms of involvement (in the development of goals/strategies and implementation of projects) requires
 - ⇒ time ... and patience
 - ⇒ money and space ... for events and campaigns
 - ⇒ (external) support, moderation und motivation

... and must continuously target mobilisation of citizens (who may still not be involved)
