Support Programs

- Regional/local support programs no special programmes but Municipality of Rakvere is supporting compilation of energy audits through UrbEnergy project
- National support programs and measures:
- EE and RE support program provided by Estonian Climate and Energy Agency - supporting the compilation of construction documents. Amount up to 90%
- International support programs:
- EE and RE support program provided by KredEx supporting compilation of energy audits, construction documents, construction process supervision. Amount up to 50%







EE and RE programs provided by KredEx supporting renovation of the apartment buildings. Amount up to 35%

EE and RE UrbEnergy – 85% of the costs provided by the programme Baltic Sea Programme 2007-2013







Practical Experience in TA

 Through implementation of UrbEnergy project, Rakvere is aiming to promote the usage of KredEx support programmes among residents in order to achieve EE and RE in renovation of existing housing stock

- Experiences: Low interest by residents, intimidated by the loan
- Possible improvements the current terms are too complicated for the end beneficiaries
