Transnational Steering Group What is this?

- A decision making body in international projects that safeguards the fulfilment of the overall project goals.
- The BSR Joint Technical Secretariat recommends the initiation of a Steering Group.

- Body within WP2 –
 Communication and Information
- Monitoring of results
- Capitalisation of joint outputs
- Ensure that common know-how on themes of WP3-5 is compiled

- Body within WP1 –
 Project Management
- Monitoring of working process
- Joint finding of solutions for difficult issues







Transnational Steering Group Members and Organisation

- Members: Lead Partner, Project Coordinator, National Project Coordinators and Workpackage Coordination Teams
- Coordination: Project Coordinator
- Meetings: At least once per project period;
 TSG may come together on an ad-hoc basis if there are important issues to decide on.





Transnational Steering Group Main Activities/Tasks

- Monitoring of project implementation
- Decisions on all aspects that concern the project as a whole, i.e. important actions, significant amendments, delays in procedure or settlement of disputes.
